4) **PRESENTATION TO PARTICIPANT: -**

Dr. Jaganath Hembrom, in charge malnutrition department civil hospital, Secretary Arogya Foundation of India West Singhbhum delivered talk on malnutrition and Anaemia. As he spoke in local language the scores of women present, greeted him with full applause and were able to understand the topic in depth. He explained them what sort of food is called nutrition and the causes of stunted children in the area. He stressed upon the care of the pregnant women lack of which is the chief reason of severe Anaemia amongst local women. He also stressed upon washing hands before taking meals which causes worm infestation amongst children leading to Anaemia.
