3. **HIGHLIGHT AND INAUGURATION**

The Camp was inaugurated by Prof. Lohra Mahto, a social worker and ward member Smt. Sheela Devi by lighting lamp before Maa Saraswati. They were accompanied by Dr. M. S. Bhatt, President Jharkhand AFI, Dr. A. K. Agrawal, member AFI and Prof. Microbiology–Ranchi Medical College and CTO Arogya-Rajnath Mahto. It was followed by recitation of Om and prayer of Saraswati by the children of Ekal Vidyalaya.

4. **PRESENTATION TO PARTICIPANT**

- **Dr. A.K.Agarwal**, Prof Microbiology delivered speech before the villagers for health awareness, He said that human body has two kidneys. When both of them fail then at least one has to be transplanted. This costs at least Rs.3 lacs. In the same way a human has two eyes, two ears, two legs and two hands with 32 teeth. If cost of all these organs is summarized the amount will be in Arabs of rupees. Thus one should be very careful to protect and maintain health of this body. He said that the only medicine to keep the body healthy is to follow healthy daily routine and eat nutritious food. It is essential to wake up early, do proper exercise and pranayam. We should also eat green leafy vegetables, seasonal fruits and balanced quantity of diet.
- **Dr. M. S. Bhatt**. He advised that if one follows routine prescribed by **Dr. Agarwal** he will have to sleep early too, so that he may rise early in the morning. This will really help keeping health.
- **Prof. Lohra Mahto** expressed gratitude towards the doctors from RIMS for coming to such a remote place and helping the poor patients and also enhancing knowledge about health. He also expressed desire to organize such camps more frequently so that the distance between urban elite and rural poor may be mitigated.
